- Improve processes, prepare yearly report requirements and yearly budget and coordinate statutory and fiscal filings and carry out ad-hoc projects.
- Responsible for maintaining and reconciling the General ledger accounts on a daily basis.
- Responsible for month end closing entries to G/L accounts.
- Responsible for controlling of coding Accounts Payable invoices of payments and of accounts Receivable manual invoices.
